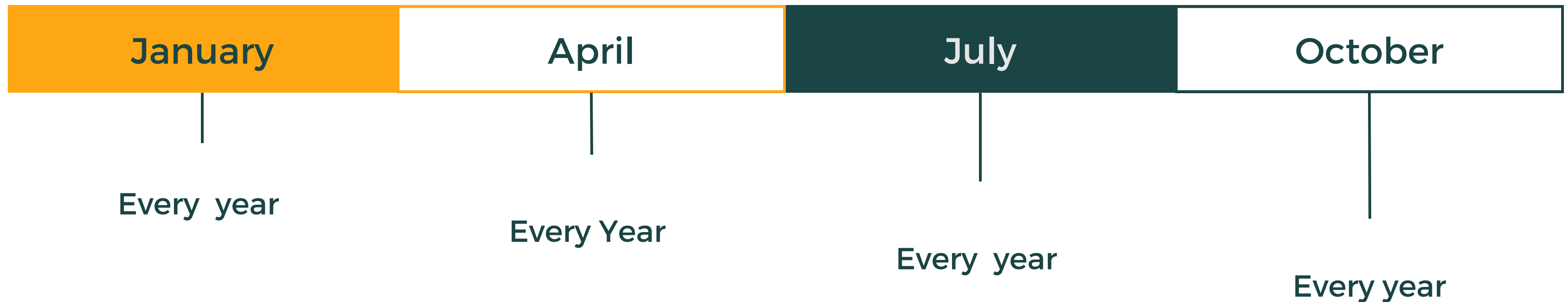

DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Collect Required Documents for immigration

The specific document requirements for applying residence permit or visa can vary depending on the authority and country you are applying to. However, here is a list of standard documents that are often required during the visa process.

STEP-2

VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT PROCESS

Scheduling appointments with SEF for applying for a residence permit under the appropriate immigration article.

Scheduling appointments with the Portuguese consulate if applying from abroad for a visa. Essential to understanding the visa category before the request for an appointment.

SCHEDULING APPOINTMENT

Via Tele calling

- Most of the time, the SEF appointment are available on the call. Follow the instructions to book a suitable date and time for your work. Be flexible with your availability if possible.

Via Email

- In this particular situation, schedule SEF appointment only by email.

STEP-3

VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT PROCESS

TRANSLATION CERTIFICATION

If your original documents are not in Portuguese, you must have them translated into Portuguese by a certified or professional translator. The translation should be accurate and complete, preserving all the information from the original document.

In some cases, you may be required to obtain a certified translation. A certified translation includes a statement signed by the translator or translation agency affirming the accuracy and completeness of the translation. This statement should also include the translator's contact information.

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STEP-4

VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT PROCESS

SUBMISSION & FINGERPRINT

Attend Biometric Appointment: On the scheduled appointment date, attend the biometric appointment at the designated SEF centre or consulate/embassy. Your fingerprints and sometime other biometric data, such as a photograph, may be collected during this appointment.

Provide Necessary Documentationn: With your fingerprints, submit all required supporting documents, including your passport, application form, photographs, and other documents specified in the application guidelines.

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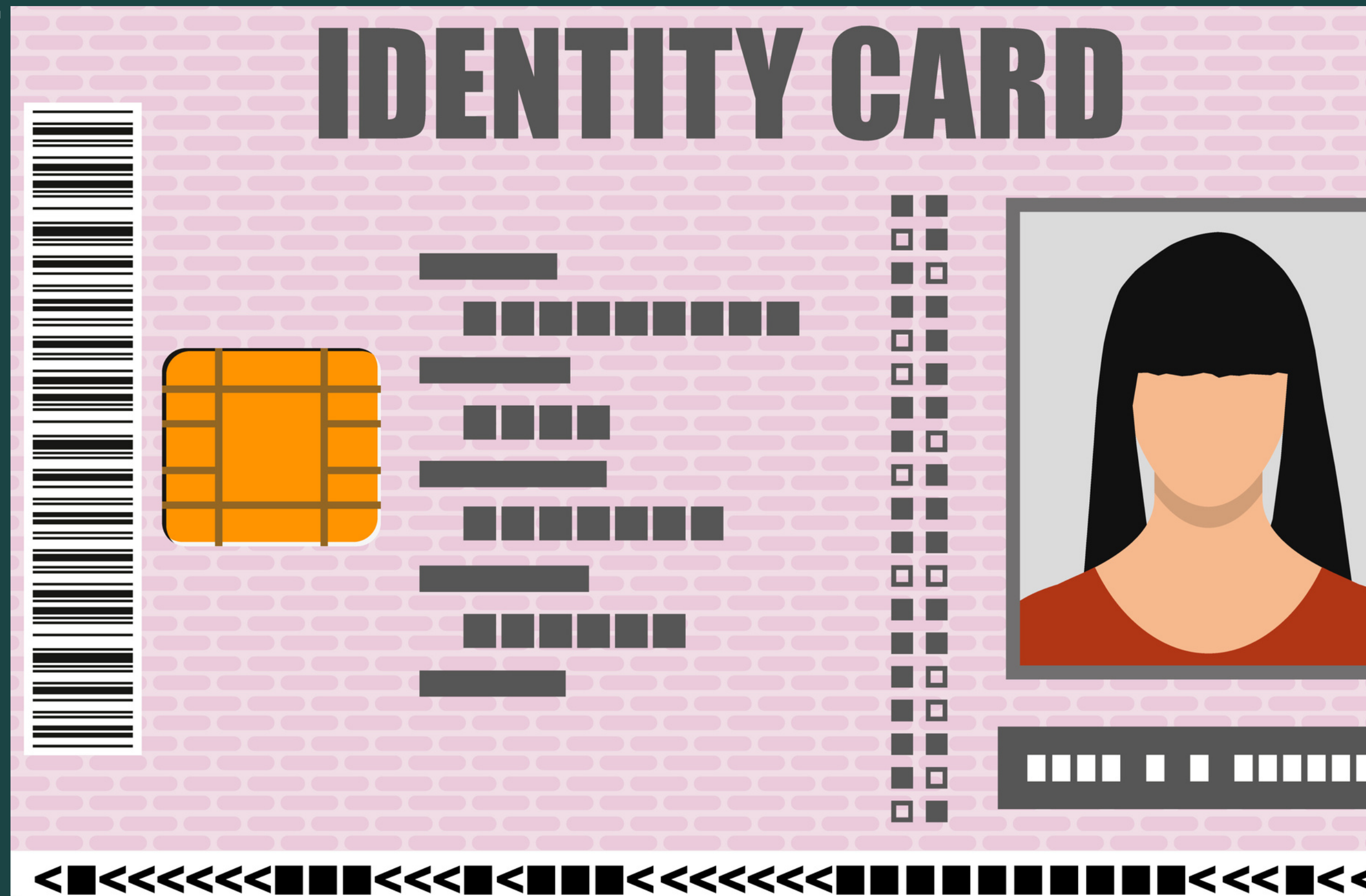
